The Service Delivery System is designed to provide Oaklanders with improved services. While we realize that there are many issues in the district and limited resources, it is incumbent upon the team to develop ways in which to focus the many interests into a few tangible projects that will produce visible results in the district.

The team consists of community members, council members, police, fire, and Public Works, Community Economic Development Agency, Life Enrichment Agency, as well as the City Attorney's office.
